




Dwarfism Awareness Day

The Early Learning Career Center (ELCC) offers professional development services and support to all DCF-licensed early learning programs, family child care homes, and educators in Miami-Dade County. As part of the Miami-Dade Thrive by 5 Early Learning Quality Improvement System (QIS), the ELCC provides career advising and educator scholarships in support of a diverse workforce. In addition, the ELCC connects early childhood educators in Miami-Dade to Forum professional development supports such as Early Childhood Educator INCENTIVE\$ Florida and the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® Scholarship Program.

Funding for the registries is provided by The Children's Trust.

Professional Development Registries Fun Fact: QIS educators have higher quality interactions with the children in their classrooms when they hold degrees, accept more scholarships, and receive INCENTIVE\$ financial supports.
