
In loving memory of Dr. Wil Blechman

This issue of *Forum Focus* is dedicated in loving memory of our longtime Board Member, Dr. Wil Blechman, who passed away on September 15, 2021. Dr. Wil, as he was known to thousands, was a staunch advocate for young children and loved the work of the Forum and other organizations that focused on creating a better world for our children. He was a member of the Forum's board of directors for the past 20 years, serving as Vice Chair and Director Emeritus. He never missed an opportunity to share his passion and mentor others.



As a beloved husband, father, grandfather, humanitarian, child advocate, mentor, and leader, Dr. Wil was a man who gave of himself and cared for others. He graduated from Yale University and the Medical College of Virginia and formed an Internist/Rheumatologist medical group in North Miami Beach. He retired from his medical practice in 1994 and devoted himself more fully to issues affecting young children.



Dr. Wil was a former President of Kiwanis International, a State of Florida Health Officer, the founding president of the Florida Association for Infant Mental Health, and a Vice President of The Children's Trust of Miami Dade County. He authored and supported many programs, which benefited children and families. He was especially committed to educating legislators and business leaders on the science of brain development in children during the early years.

Among countless awards and recognitions, Dr. Wil was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society

in 2018 by the Medical College of Virginia. In addition, the Florida Kiwanis Foundation created the **Wil and Rachel Fund** to support Kiwanis programs and initiatives which benefit young children in Florida.

Dr. Wil lived to make a difference for others, especially in his pursuit of social justice and optimizing early environments for young children. As we mourn his loss, we continue to be inspired by his legacy. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family at this difficult time.




