

Children's Forum Legislative Agenda

This year's legislative session is in full swing and appears to be a promising one for Florida's families and early childhood educators. Our state's legislative leadership believes that investments in early care and education (ECE) create an environment for children to succeed in school and in life.

In partnership with the Early Learning Consortium, the Forum's 2019 legislative priorities include the following ECE initiatives:

- Implement HB 1091 to ensure that differential (premium) payments and professional development opportunities are available to early childhood educators.
- Implement House Bill 1193 that aims to overhaul Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) evaluations by adequately measuring learning gains and readiness across all appropriate domains.
- Increase investments in the VPK Base Student Allocation, which would allow child care program directors to afford the resources necessary for high-quality programming.
- Appropriate \$4.5 million in funding to current Help Me Grow® Florida (HMG) Affiliates and expand the program that provides developmental screenings, care coordination, and outreach to address health and behavioral concerns among children ages 0-8.
- Appropriate \$10 million in funding to the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® Scholarship Program. This funding would provide approximately 8,000 scholarships for early childhood educators to earn degrees or credentials. T.E.A.C.H. is inlcuded in both the House and Senate budgets.
- Unfortunately, a bill that would have appropriated \$525,000 in funding for early learning coalitions to opt-in to the Child Care WAGE\$® FLORIDA Program did not pass. We will work on getting it passed during next year's legislative session.

Child Care AGE\$® **FLORIDA**

Because you asked, issues of Forum Focus will now spotlight one of our programs or services. In doing so, other Forum departments will better understand the important role we all play in fulfilling our mission. This issue's spotlight features the Child Care WAGE\$® FLORIDA program.

The Child Care WAGE\$® FLORIDA program (WAGE\$) rewards early childhood educators

with salary supplements based on their education and retention with their employer. Designed to increase the quality of child care programs, WAGE\$ addresses marketplace competition for better salaries, supports the professional growth of teachers, and reduces teacher turnover to create stable learning environments for children. Operated by the Forum, WAGE\$ participants can earn \$200-\$3,000 more per year.

We are excited to announce that the Child Care WAGE\$® FLORIDA Program (WAGE\$) is now available in Hillsborough and Pinellas counties! This will allow us to provide salary supplements to thousands of early childhood educators. The program is also available in Miami-Dade and Broward counties.
