

Podcast Committee Update

Forum Talks is the first Podcast of its kind in Florida to discuss state-specific early care and education (ECE) initiatives. Since last September, the committee has developed two podcasts. The first Podcast featured a discussion with Phyllis Kalifeh, President and CEO, on the state of ECE in Florida. The second Podcast included a panel presentation that was recorded at the 2017 One Goal Summer Conference. The presentation highlighted personal stories from early childhood educators and the impact of the Forum's T.E.A.C.H. and WAGE\$ programs in achieving their professional development objectives.
